# Principal's Report 2020 & 2021

## Good Morning to You All!!!

I cordially invite and welcome you all on behalf of Hartley family. After an unusual and exceptionally challenging years 2020 and 2021, everyone is excited and back together in person in 2022. I am privileged and honoured to present principal's report. I am extremely proud to represent this prestigious college and celebrate with you the success of our students here today. Year 2020 & 2021 have been very challenging year for everyone in this world, especially for schools in all over the world. We were collapsed with the covid - 19 pandemic and had to react to the situation constantly. Within a short notice, the schools were closed on 13th of March 2020. Fortunately we were able to conduct the Annual Sports Meet on 14th of February 2020. Thereafter we were unable to hold the usual functions of the college during the stipulated time frame of the years of 2020 and 2021. With covid – 19 becoming part of our vocabulary, we have finally adjusted to what is now referred to as new normal and engulfed in school routine. And we are here today to celebrate the Prize day of both years 2020 and 2021.

It is a great honour to have Dr. Ratnasingam Thanigaivasan as the chief guest for this event. Dr. Ratnasingam Thanigaivasan had his Secondary Education at J/ Hartley College, Point Pedro from 1994 to 2002. He excelled in studies obtaining nine distinctions and a credit pass at G.C.E O/L examination held in 1999. He became the First in Jaffna District and 42nd in Island in the G.C.E A/L examination for the year 2002 and was selected to the Faculty of Medicine, University of Colombo to study medicine. While studying at Hartley College he was part of Athletics and Quiz teams of the College and represented the school at Zonal and District levels which paved the way for him to become the prefect of the College in the year of 2000.

Currently Dr. Thanigaivasan is serving as the Senior Medical Officer in Pediatric Surgery at Lady Ridgeway Hospital for Children which is the premier baby friendly hospital in South Asian region. He obtained PG certificates in Statistics and Epidemiology from the University of Colombo and involving several research activities.

Further he was elected as General Committee member of the Government Medical Officers' Association and functioning as one of its Media Spokesperson at present. He involves in the matter related to national interest extensively as an activist of a leading professional association.

He married to Dr Mayuri who is also a Medical doctor in 2018, currently she pursues her post graduate education in the field of Anesthesiology.

For the last two years even though we have gone through many hurdles, we never gave up to cultivate the best in both academic and co-curricular activities.

#### **Academic Achievements:**

Let's start with academic. 2020 & 2021 were the years of unpredicted events which had a significant impact on both school operations and students learning, due to the pandemic situation. G.C.E (A/L) August 2020 was postponed to October 2020. In G.C.E (A/L) 2020, nine students secured 3A's, among them six students from physical science stream, two students from Biological science stream and one student from commerce stream. Pass percentage of physical science stream is 65%, and Biological science stream is 76%, Commerce 60%, Arts 71%, Engineering Technology 51% and Bio Technology 83%.

G.C.E (A/L) 2021 was not held in 2021 and postponed to February 2022. In G.C.E (A/L) 2021, fifteen students got 3A's, among them twelve from physical science two from Biological science stream and one student from Bio Technology. Pass Percentage of Physical science is 64% Biological science is 61%, Commerce 71%, Arts 69%, Engineering Technology 67% and Bio system Technology 83% and other stream is 100%.

G.C.E.(O/L) December 2020 was postponed and held in January 2021. In this exam, Twenty one students got 9A s and seventeen students got 8A s. We got the 97 percentage eligible to study A/L. Also our students got 100 pass percentage for Catholicism, Christianity, Tamil, Geography, Music, Art, English Literature, Tamil Literature and Health Science.

In addition to these two main examinations, we had to implement various methods to conduct the school with the guidance from the Ministry of Health. The vivid pandemic situation forced us to start our academic sessions virtually instead of physical classes. Virtual classes via zoom app were conducted for the A/L students in 2020. In 2021 we have started the virtual classes for all grades. Earlier we used the zoom app and later we switched on to Teams app to conduct the classes. According to a well-planned timetable, the classes were conducted during the weekdays from 8. a.m to 12.30 p.m. I am proud that our staff and students had risen to face the changes and adapted to the situation very well. Schools were opened and closed time to time for the academic activities. According to the guidelines from the ministry of health, the secondary students were divided into two groups and attended the school physically in the alternative days. It was a big challenge for our staff. To overcome from this issue, the virtual classes were

conducted for the students who were at home. We arranged the online facilities to the classrooms and made the teachers to reach the students at home as well. Students attended the live classes.

In addition to this, it became necessary to think about the welfare of our students. Some students were suffered a lot to fulfill their basic food need. With great determination, HCPPA has come forward to issue the dry rations to the underprivileged students.

Setting up the school environment and the classes according to the instructions from the Ministry of Health, was a challenging and important duty in both years. Arranging the classes maintaining the social distance, checking the temperature of every student when he entered the school, setting automatic hand washing places, maintaining a separate health center, disposal of the used items etc... To fulfill these needs Velummayilum foundation and HCPPA gave their hands as always and we were able to set everything perfectly within a short period of time. Our staff also gave their full support to make this school as a safety place for everyone.

#### Co-curricular activities:

Covid-19 pandemic has disrupted many of our key programmers of the school. We were unable to conduct the Annual sports meet, prize giving, vani vizha, Oli Vizha, Teachers' day, children's day and many others. In 2021, we were able to conduct the annual prize giving 2020 and the launching of the miscellany with the limited number of students and invitees. Mas.S.Ananthikan participated in the essay competition, conducted by the Spectrum Institute, and secured the first place at the National Level, under the over 14 category. Mas. S.Elilkumaran from grade 9, secured the place within 1-5 in the Robo fest 2021 Competition, conducted by Yarl Geek.

English day competition, Tamil day competition, sports, aesthetic competition and many other important competitions were not conducted by the government due to the prevailing situation of the country.

To develop the leadership skills and self-esteem Hindu Association, Christianity Association, English Literary Association, Science Association, Social Science Association, Environmental pioneers brigade, Disaster Management Group, Scouts Association and Student parliament are functioning well at our college. I would like to share some few words about the Reading project. A project named "The Best Reader "is being conducted by the English unit to encourage the reading habit among students and certificates and prizes are issued to those students who complete all the aspects of the project.

#### **Human Resources:**

#### In 2020

There were in all one thousand four hundred and fifty six students, seventy one teachers and seven Nonacademic staff.

There were Nineteen students presently occupied in the school hostel.

### **And in 2021**

There were in all One thousand four hundred and eighty three students, sixty nine teachers and seven Nonacademic staff.

One of the sectional heads Mr.S.Sivaganeshan , got his retirement on  $19^{th}$  of August 2021, after a long dedicated service to the College.

Twenty one students occupied the hostel.

- A room was upgraded as a self-learning spot for A/L students with the financial support of Mr.Nadaraja Surendran (President- HCPPA –UK)
- Glass fitting for the A/L classrooms were done with the financial assistance of Mr.Rajaskanthan (Former Deputy Principal) and HCPPA-Colombo.
- Scouts equipment were donated by HCPPA- Colombo Branch.
- Internal Sound System was installed with the financial support of Mr.Sivaganeshan (Former Sectional Head)

#### **Activities of the Associations**

#### Hindu Association

The Hindu Association was established to promote the knowledge of Hinduism and moral values among the students. This association is a platform, not only for teaching the moral values but also to explore the talents of the students. Special prayers are held at the school auditorium in every Fridays. Each and every classes take responsibilities of each Friday. The whole event is presided over by the students. Special prayer arrangements and a student from that class deliver a speech on the theme given by the Hindu Association. A message of Thirukkural has been delivered by the students from A/L and a moral speech is given by a teacher.

Gurupoojas of Nayanmars and Vani vizha are celebrated by Hindu Association. A retired teacher of Hartley College is invited as the guest speaker for the vani vizha celebration. To give opportunities for everyone to experience the culture and develop their abilities, aesthetic programmes are staged on that day by our boys. Also special competitions are conducted by our Teacher-in-charge for the Navarathri festival and prizes are given at the Vani vizha celebration.

Due to the Covid -19 pandemic, the key activities of the association were totally collapsed. We were unable to conduct the assembly, Vanivizha and many other religious activities. In 2020 and 2021, the Navarathri Pooja was conducted in the hostel premises, Study center respectively, with the principal and limited staff. We hope that our usual activities of this forum will be back to normal in upcoming days.

### • Christianity Association

Special prayers are held on every Fridays with delivering thoughts from Bible. 'Oli vizha' is celebrated with the cultural programmes and carol services. The pandemic situation has disturbed the activities of the association and we were unable to celebrate the Oli Vizha in both 2020 and 2021.

#### Science Association

This association is functioning with the collaboration of science, and Maths streams. Through this association, the students participate in various competitions such as Science quiz, Maths quiz, Young Inventors competition, poster competition, speeches, and innovative creations and win the prizes every year. Due to the pandemic situation of the country, Maths Olympiad, Science Olympiad and more other competitions were not held in 2020 and 2021. Also we were unable to launch the annual magazine 'Thedal' due to the prevailing situation of the country.

#### Social Science Association

Social Science Association is functioning with the collaboration of Arts, Commerce and Technology streams. Through this association, The students from Arts, Commerce and Technology streams participate at various competitions and win the prizes every year. No competitions have been held for the last two years (2020 and 2021) due to the uncertainty caused by the Covid - 19 pandemic. But, the Social Science Association launched its seventh magazine "Vazhi" on 12<sup>th</sup> August 2020 with the valuable support and precious contribution of our students and the dedicated teachers.

### • English Literary Association

English Literary Association meeting is regularly conducted in class level. All the students actively participate in it. All the students get the chances to express their unique talents. Students are able to acquire knowledge and gain experience through different programmes like role-play, oratory-prepared, impromptu, recitation and so on. Due to the pandemic situation of the country, English Day Competitions were not conducted in both 2020 and 2021. But, our students participated in on-line essay competitions and won many prizes at the National level.

#### Scouts Association

The Scouts have actively participated in the competition and win the prizes. They provide their services during the festival times of the famous temples in Vadamaradchy Vallipura Alwar Temple and Sannithy Murugan Temple. They provide their social services in our school special function, Divisional and Zonal Level Athletic meet.

The National Environmental Pioneer programme is implemented by the Central Environmental authority in the school system with the support of Ministry of Education. Its main objective is bequeathing the environmental heritage of our motherland to future generation. There are two Environmental brigades functioning at our school. 50 students from grade 8 and 9 got their green batches in 2020. Student pioneers had done a march past at the Annual sports meet along with their flags to make an awareness about environmental safety. Also we conducted shramadana campaigns to clean the school premises. Even though we have faced covid 19 pandemic, we were able to conduct environment friendly activities during 2020 and 2021.

#### Health Club

The overall goal of the school is to promote effective learning in school through supporting pupils to increase their knowledge and understanding of health issues that affect them directly and guide them to adopt positive behaviors to prevent poor health. During the year 2020 and 2021 were very challenging and the health club has played a vital role. The club has worked out to make the safety environment against Covid19. For the physical environmental prevention, sinks with automatic taps were fixed in the school premises with the support of HCPPA and Velummayilum foundation and our staff.

An observation room was placed for those who exhibited symptoms. Weekly, all classrooms and other places were sterilized by contractual external experts. Every day, the body temperature of the students and staff was checked before entering the school. The furniture in the classrooms were rearranged to maintain a gap of 1 m. In addition, the parents were informed that not to send their children to school if they exhibited any Covid symptoms. Most of the children in the country were under stress due to the Covid situation and online education for a long term. Therefore, we have conducted some seminars to the O/L and A/L students about 'stress Management'. More than this Covid issues, Health club continues its normal activities such as Vaccinating, Dental health, BMI, Physical education, and etc with the support of the administration and the Ministry of Health.

## Past Pupils' Association

Past Pupils' Association is a vital artery of Hartley College, Point-Pedro. HCPPA Parent body, Colombo branch, Vanni branch, UK branch, USA & Canada branch, NSW branch, Victoria branch and Swiss branch are the eight branches which keep in touch with each other and assist and support in various ways to College such as educational development, development of infrastructure, sports, Co-curricular activities, hostel maintenance and so on.
